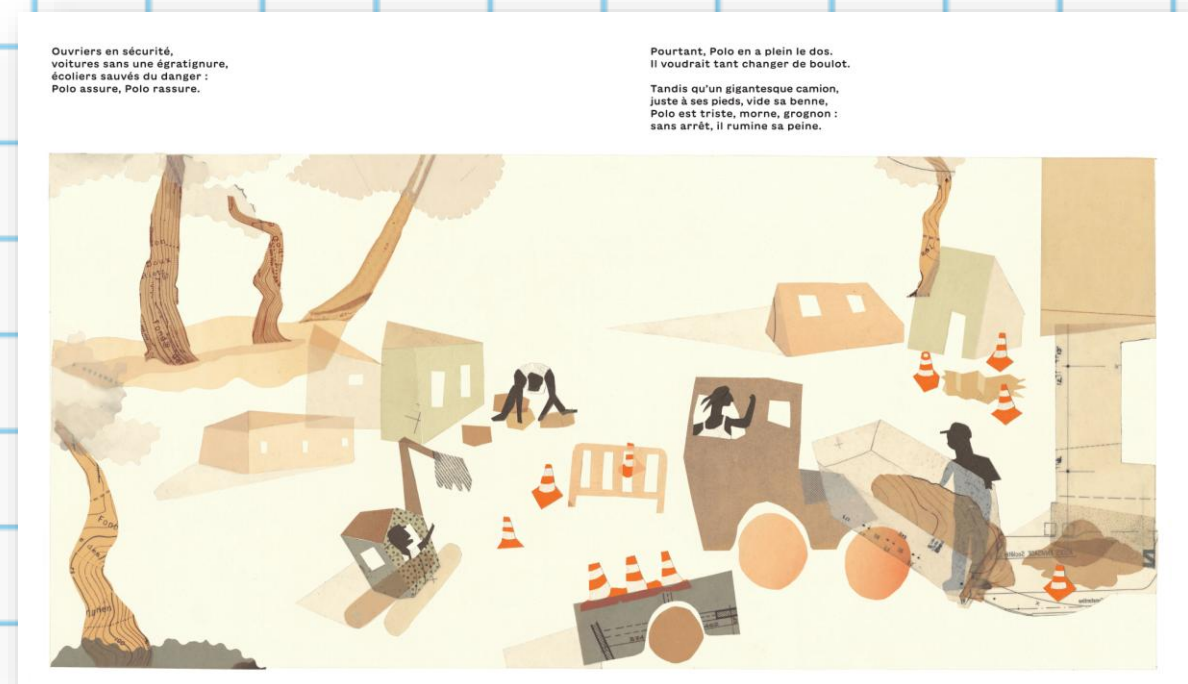
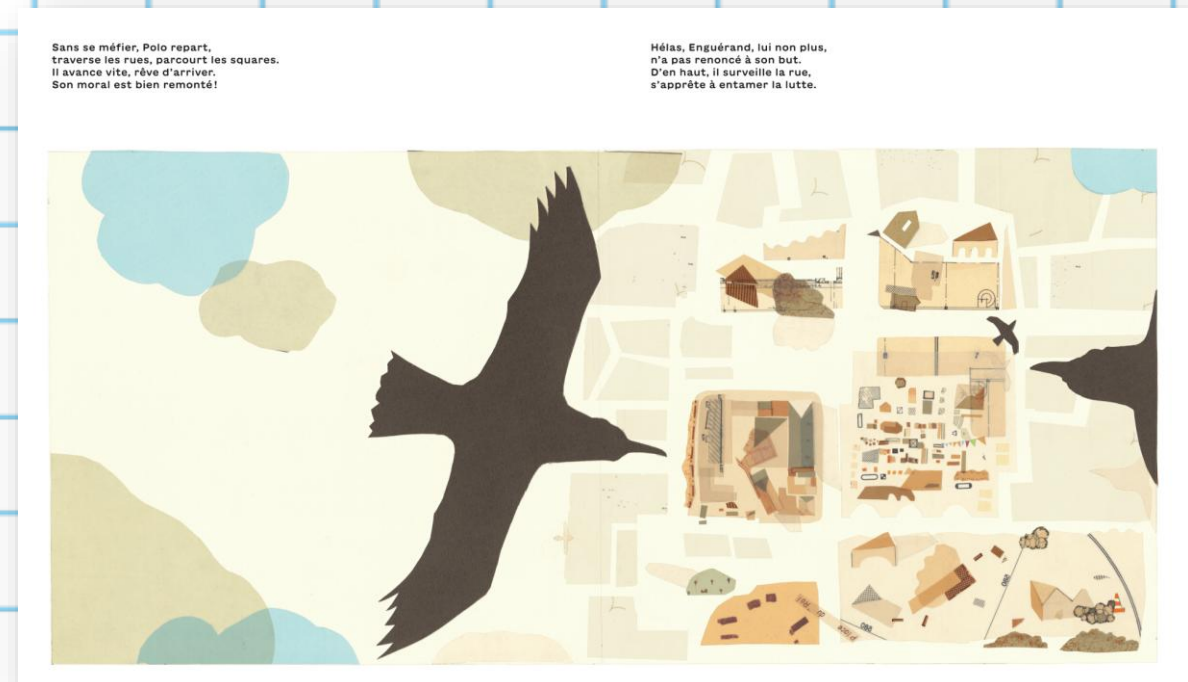
POLO LE PLOT

Polo

An uplifting picture book about freedom, self-determination, and the joy of reinventing oneself.

Polo is the story of an unlikely hero: a traffic cone. Not a warrior, not a prince, just a silent, orange cone standing on construction sites, keeping workers, drivers, and children safe. Polo takes his job seriously, but deep down, he dreams of something else. One day, inspired by a pile of golden sand whispering of the sea, he decides to leave the grey city behind and set off on a journey toward the beach. With courage and ingenuity, he hops, hides, and travels through streets and markets, facing fear and doubt. His greatest obstacle is a stern seagull who believes everyone and everything must stay in their assigned role. When Polo finally stands up for himself, he affirms his right to choose his own path and imagine a different future. At the seaside, Polo finds what he was searching for: not fame or glory, but play, laughter, and belonging. Polo has found his place, simply by daring to change.

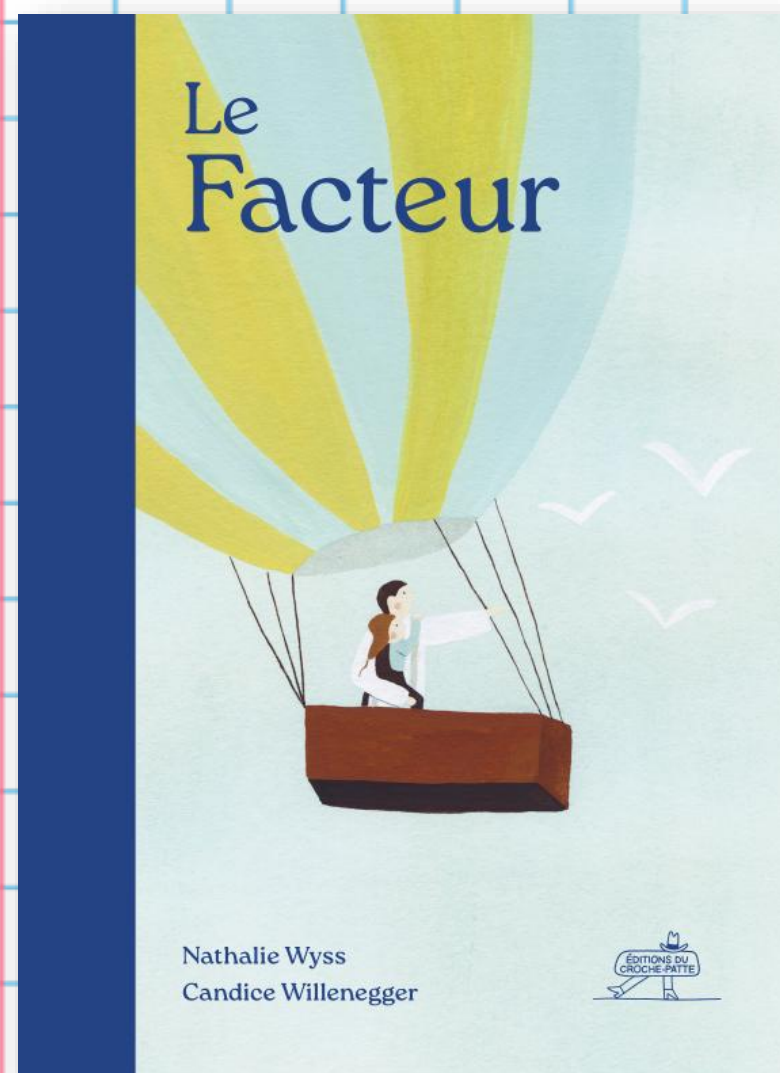
- With poetic language and playful rhythm, this picture book transforms an everyday urban object into a lovable hero facing universal questions.

A story of intergenerational friendship that gently and poetically explores the theme of hypersensitivity.

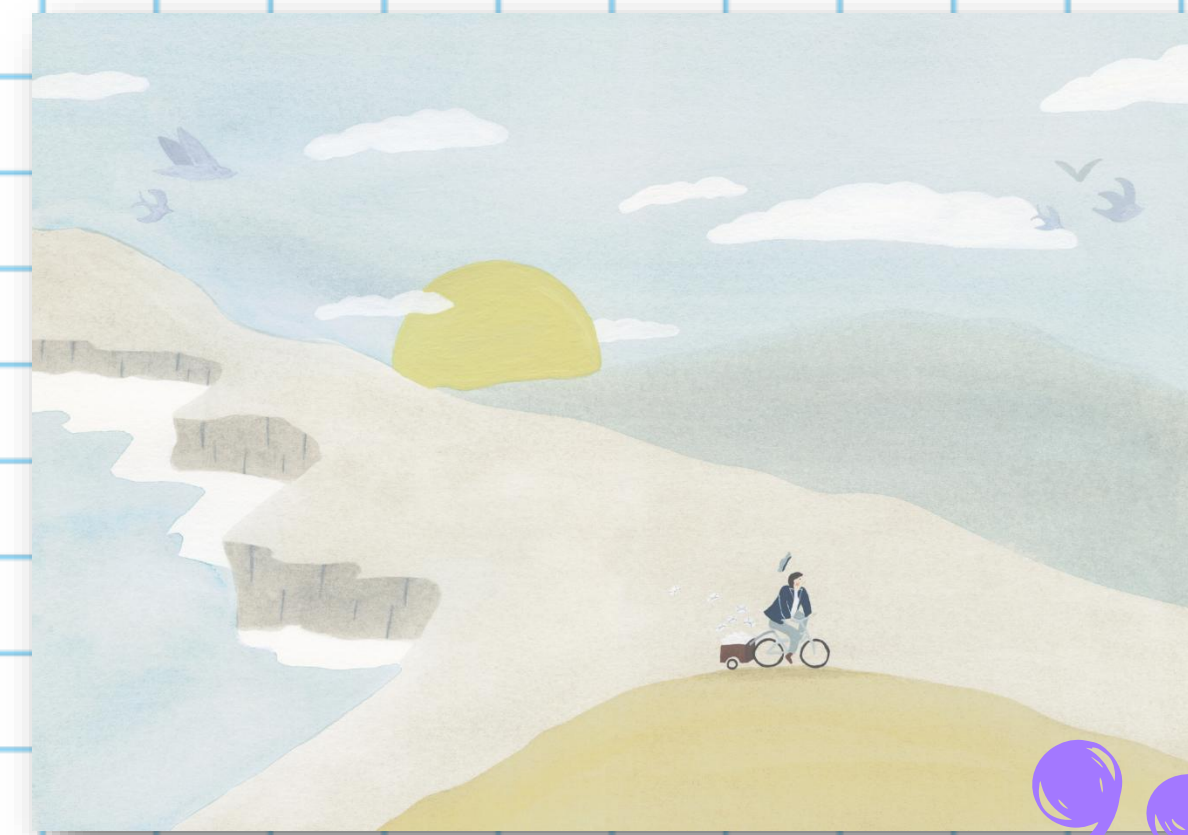

One day, he meets Tom, a lonely ten-year-old boy who dreams of flying in a hot-air balloon. Tom is waiting for the result of a contest he entered, unaware that the company organizing it ceased to exist over a century ago.

When the postman discovers the truth, he is devastated. Unable to crush the child's dream, he makes a reckless decision: he forges a letter announcing that Tom has won.

What begins as a small lie grows into a race against time and conscience, as the postman desperately searches for a way to make the impossible come true!
